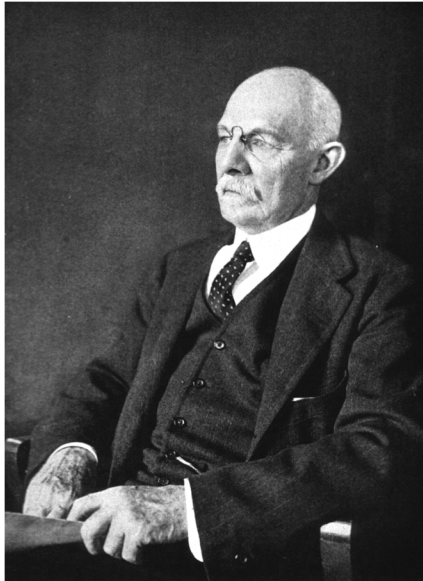

### **Driving Directions to Children’s National Hospital:**

1. Using GPS, first navigate to the intersection of “Fern St NW and 13th Place NW”. (Navigation apps will accept intersections as shown. Do not use the building address, as GPS apps will direct you through the larger Walter Reed campus on roads that are not open.)
2. Turn south on 13th Place, your only option, and proceed to the second entrance of the parking garage on your left. Park on the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> level and proceed to the Pedestrian Exit located at the south end of Level 2 (where you entered).
3. 7115 13th Place (the Conference Theater) is directly south of the garage, to the right upon your exit.

### **Driving Directions from the hotel to the Louis Stokes Library at Howard University (501 W St NW):**

1. From the hotel, head left on New Jersey Ave NW (away from the Capitol building).
2. Turn left onto Florida St NW, and then immediately bear right onto 5<sup>th</sup> St NW.
3. Proceed down 5<sup>th</sup> St NW to W St NW and turn left.
4. Turn right onto 6<sup>th</sup> St NW, and then right onto Bryant St NW.
5. The Stokes Library is two blocks up on the right. Park in the lot just behind the library on the right.

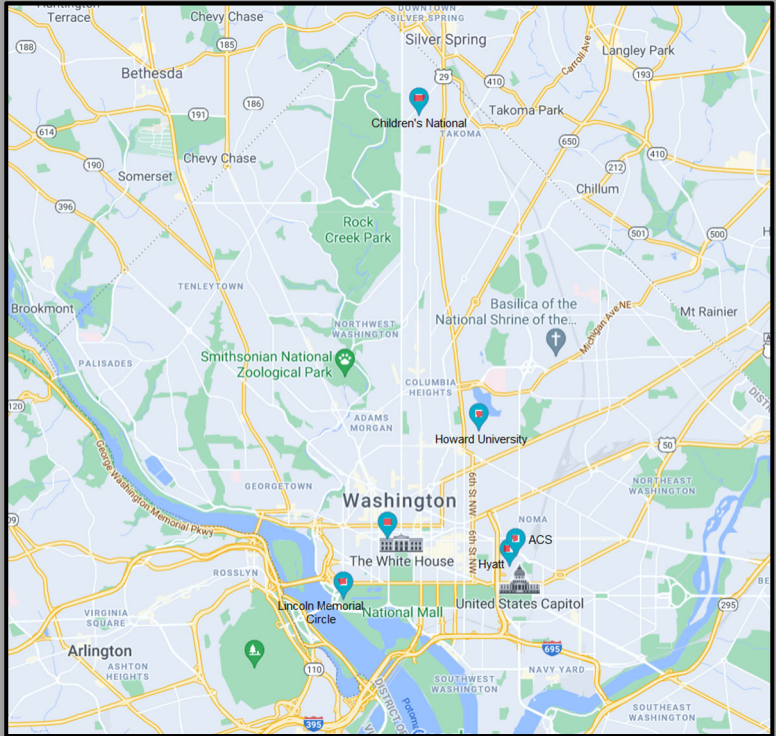
### **Walking Directions from the hotel to the ACS 20F Street Conference Center:**
