Emergent properties: nature's way of improvising

In philosophy, systems theory, science, and art, emergence occurs when an entity is observed to have properties its parts do not have on their own, properties or behaviors which emerge only when the parts interact in a wider whole.

Improvisation occurs at all scales of life and requires bidirectional "chemosignaling"
